Presenter:

John F. Warren, III received his Ph.D. from Duke University in 1980 and since that time has practiced clinical psychology in North Carolina in a number of inpatient, outpatient, and correctional settings. He participated in the Winston-Salem Police Academy in 1987. He completed the forensic training program at the Institute of Law, Psychiatry and Public Policy at the University of Virginia in 1989. He is listed in the National Register of Health Service Providers in Psychology, is an elected member of the American Academy of Forensic Sciences, and he is board certified in both Forensic Psychology and Police and Public Safety Psychology by the American Board of Professional Psychology (ABPP). After years of clinical practice he returned to complete a three-year Physician Assistant medical program in 2002 and became certified as a physician assistant (PA-C) in 2005. In addition to his clinical forensic practice, he works one day a week in a family medicine practice, specializing in behavioral medicine and psychopharmacology.

Dr. Warren conducts complex psychological evaluations in the specialty areas of clinical, medical, forensic, and police psychology. These include risk assessments, evaluations of patients with primary medical problems and work injuries, disability evaluations, Independent Medical Evaluations, Fitness for Duty evaluations, and evaluations originating from criminal, civil and family law processes. In addition to his private practice he is a Managing Member of The FMRT Group (www.FMRT.com), a North Carolina company that provides medical and psychological services to about 300 public safety agencies through seven, statewide offices. Dr. Warren has been qualified as an expert witness in state, federal and military courts more than 250 times.
